Who is the Qualification for:

### Dry Cleaning Operations Level 2

This NVQ will provide recognition for Dry Cleaning Operatives involved in classifying and making up loads, using the dry cleaning process through to the finishing of garments or items.

### Dry Cleaning Service Support Level 2

This NVQ would be appropriate for counter staff, those who work in repair and alterations, final inspection, and despatch and packing.

### Laundry Operations Level 2

This qualification will provide recognition for Laundry Operatives working in all areas of the laundry sector from inspection through the washing or continuous batch washing process to despatch.

### Laundry Operations: Batch Washing Level 2

This NVQ would be appropriate for Laundry Operatives working in Batch Washing.

### Laundry Service Support Level 2

This NVQ would be appropriate for Laundry Assistants, those who work in repair and alterations, and despatch and delivery.
